## Bid for Region 6 Spring 2014 Meeting

As many of you are aware, the Missouri JCI Senate is preparing a bid to host the Spring 2014 Region 6 Meeting in Kansas City. We will be discussing this bid in detail at our state meeting on Jan 19th. Here are some of the highlights as of now.

The meeting is planned for the weekend of April 11-13, 2014. The proposed location is the Ramada Conference Center KC, near 1-435 and Front Street. This hotel was formerly The Park Place Hotel.

Registration for the weekend is \$65 in advance, \$75 after March 10th. Room rates for the weekend are \$83 a night, which includes Thursday if anyone wishes to come early (more on this below). Room rate includes breakfast at the hotel.

There is an area of the hotel (third floor), that has several conference rooms we will use for various activities, including hospitality (can bring our own food, drink, etc into this area), silent auction, card game area, and breakout meetings. There is an outdoor balcony that wraps around these rooms, which overlooks a lake, that would be usable as well if the weather cooperates. The cost for these rooms is built into our regular hotel room rate.

Combo of spaces for our use on Saturday for the meeting, lunch, and other breakout sessions as needed.

Original plan was to do a lunch at the hotel Saturday afternoon. However a number of people have suggested that the main meal on Saturday should be a dinner, so we have some options being looked at. Still awaiting cost figures on a couple of these.

As a result, there will be a couple different budgets prepared. We have a tentative one right now based on doing a lunch on Sat, with conservative costs for weekend hospitality, and some misc supplies needed that gives us a good profit based on variable levels of attendance. Dinners are usually a little more costly, so doing that would obviously lower our profit a bit.. I will be sending out a new budget report after we get our cost updates on these dinner options. Will have Ken send an eblast in advance of the meeting.

We are also considering some optional events Thurs nite and Friday during the day, such as a golf outing or other activities for those who may be interested in coming to town a day early. These items, such as golf, would be an additional cost.

There will be discussion on this at the meeting on Jan 19th at the Lake. Your input would be appreciated, so we would like to see you at the meeting if possible. Our bid will be presented at the next Region 6 Meeting in April in Watertown, SD. We would encourage all Senators to come to this event to help support our bid. If you have any questions, or would like some additional info from me, please let me know.


