Jack Eggman, WMA 1949 through 1957

John "Jack" Eggman to be inducted into the St. Louis Tennis Hall of Fame

We have just learned that John "Jack" Eggman, Wentworth Military Academy Midget Basketball player, Indian Dancer, High School & College Letterman and member of the Wentworth Athletic Hall of Fame will be inducted in the St. Louis Tennis Hall of Fame.

Jack was instrumental in organizing the effort to build tennis courts in all parts of greater St. Louis and surrounding areas enabling youth from all backgrounds to

learn and play the game of tennis. He was most effective while serving as "Tennis Chairman" of the St. Louis Junior Chamber of Commerce. In 2008, Jack authored a book, *The Roots of Tennis* which was deemed one of the best historical sports book written.

We lost Jack suddenly in 2010 but we know this honor would bring him tremendous happiness. The induction ceremony will take place in May.
